TERMS AND CONDITIONS

NC State University IGERT in Genetic Pest Management - IGERT Fellow

Here we outline the terms of the agreement to be made by IGERT, the student, and the student's advisor.

IGERT agrees to:

- 1. Provide a graduate fellowship for two years in the amount of \$30,000 per year, as well as tuition and fees contingent upon satisfactory academic performance. There is the possibility of a third year of support for some students.
- 2. Identify funding through graduate departments to cover the remaining 2-3 years of a graduate program. These funds may be in the form of Research Assistantship and Teaching Assistantships.
- 3. Provide support for student progress on IGERT related activities, including required courses, colloquia, and resources to support student research where appropriate and feasible.

The Student agrees to:

- 1. Complete the four required courses, the GES minor, and the cohort project.
- 2. Complete at least one dissertation chapter on topics related to the IGERT.
- 3. Participate fully in colloquia, student discussions regarding the cohort project, and interactions with the cohort team.
- 4. Abide by IGERT guidelines for rigorous, respectful dialogue.

The Advisor agrees to:

- 1. Support the full participation and intellectual development of the student in IGERT related activities.
- 2. Participate in IGERT activities including colloquium, student recruitment, and advising.
- 3. Contribute to the development of the IGERT program.
- 4. Abide by IGERT guidelines for rigorous, respectful dialogue.
